



Two Additions to Johnson Street Bridge Citizen Advisory Committee

VICTORIA, BC — The City of Victoria welcomes community representatives, Cara Segger, and business representative Margaret Lucas, to the Citizen Advisory Committee on the Johnson Street Bridge. Ms. Segger joins the team this week, and Ms. Lucas joined the committee a few weeks ago.

In July, City Council struck the Johnson Street Bridge Public Advisory Committee, a team of respected members of the community, to provide input on the functional design and aesthetic elements of the replacement bridge. The advisory committee consists of community representatives in the areas of development, transportation, sustainability, urban design/architecture, business and heritage. The committee is chaired by City Manager Gail Stephens.

The citizen advisors have been working closely with a technical team of engineers and architects to develop draft designs that will be presented September 8. City Council will be actively soliciting input from the community on the bridge features and aesthetic.
