



Victoria City Council to Consider Options for Repair of Rail Bridge

VICTORIA, BC – Tomorrow, Victoria City Council will review the repair options for the Johnson Street Rail Bridge at the regular Governance and Priorities Committee Meeting. Last week, Council was advised that the City must close the rail bridge to rail traffic unless repairs are completed.

The structural inspection report by Stantec Consulting Ltd. showed deterioration in key vertical steel support columns on the rail bridge.
